Local dishes
unique to Nagoya, Aichi

Nagoya Meshi refers to a variety of unique local dishes long enjoyed in Nagoya and its surrounding areas, both at home and in restaurants.

A dish that becomes widely popular across local restaurants could one day be recognized as a new Nagoya Meshi. While opinions vary on what qualifies as Nagoya Meshi, here are 15 dishes selected by popular vote*.

Ultimately, Nagoya Meshi is defined by those who love and enjoy it.

Hitsumabushi
Sauce-dipped, charcoal-grilled eel served on rice. Enjoyed little by little, by scooping into a small bowl.

Misonikomi Udon
Udon simmered with rich soybean-miso soup, in bubbling hot earthen pot. The aroma and flavor of this local dish will whet your appetite.

Miso-katsu
Crispy pork cutlet topped with a rich soybean-miso sauce. A bold Nagoya-style twist on tonkatsu—also found as kushi-katsu (skewered version).

Tebasaki
Unbreaded chicken wings, fried until crispy, then coated in a sweet and spicy glaze. Finished with pepper and sesame seeds for an extra kick of flavor.

Kishimen Noodles
Wide, flat Udon served with a smooth, flavorful soy-based dipping sauce made from fish broth.

Ankake Spaghetti
Thick noodles, about 2.2 mm in diameter, coated in a peppery thick sauce called "An," which is rich in flavor.

Ten-musu
A small rice ball with shrimp tempura, wrapped in seaweed. A perfect blend of salty rice and crispy shrimp.

Dote-ni
Pork or beef organ meats stewed in a rich, spicy-sweet soybean miso soup, unlike the soy sauce-based "Motsu-ni" found elsewhere in Japan.

Teppan Spaghetti
Spaghetti seasoned with ketchup, served on a hot iron plate and topped with scrambled egg. A Nagoya coffee shop (Kissaten) classic.

Taiwan Ramen
Originating in Nagoya, this ramen is spicy Taiwan daniel noodles with a bold mix of chili and garlic, typically topped with chives and bean sprouts.

Miso Oden
Two-types of Miso Oden: one stewed in soybean-miso broth (common at izakayas, Japanese style pubs) and one stewed in soy sauce broth with miso (home-style).

Ogura Toast
A sweet treat of traditional coffee shops (Kissaten) combining buttered toast and red bean paste with a perfect balance of salty and sweet flavors.

Ebi-furai
Breaded and deep-fried prawn dish. It is especially loved in Aichi, home to delicious tiger prawns.

Curry Udon
Originated in Tokyo during the Meiji Era (late 19th century) and spread nationwide, and its unique Nagoya-style variation became popular in Nagoya and nearby areas.

Nagoya Cochin
This area is known for its highly branded local chicken, Nagoya Cochin. Known as "Kashima" because of its color and shape like an oak leaf, it has become a synonym for this chicken.

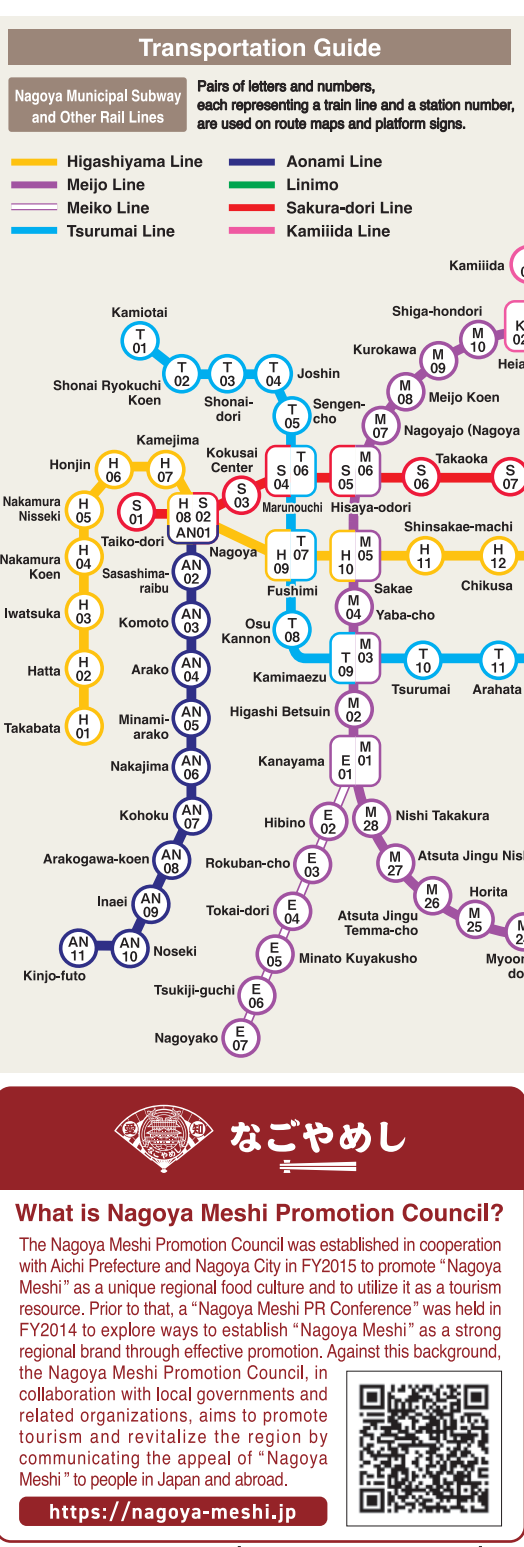
